Hawkins on the Issues

- Fair Taxes: Make the super rich and the giant corporations pay their fair share of taxes.
- End Poverty—Jobs or Income Now: Public works to guarantee living wage jobs for all. A guaranteed minimum income for all.
- Free Public Education from pre-school Head Start through college and technical schools.
- Pro-Democracy Reforms: Proportional Representation in Congress. Abolish the Electoral College. Publicly Verifiable Voting. DC Statehood.
- Restore Constitutional Rights and Civil Liberties: Repeal the Patriot Act. End government spying on lawabiding citizens and civic groups. End secret detentions, arrests without charges, secret "evidence," no access to attorneys, military tribunals for civilians, and renditions for torture.
- Abolish the Death Penalty
- End the "War on Drugs": Drug treatment on demand, not mass incarceration. End drug prohibition: legalize, regulate, and tax drugs, starting with marijuana.
- Labor Law Reform: Repeal Taft-Hartley. Majority cardcheck union recognition.
- Fair Trade: Repeal NAFTA and WTO. New trade agreements that lift up labor, social, and environmental standards across borders.
- Marriage Equality: Legalize same-sex marriage.
- **Reproductive Freedom:** Access to safe and legal abortion for all women.
- Social Security: No privatization. Secure funding for the future by raising the cap on the Social Security tax for high incomes.
- **Pension Security:** Make corporations pay 10% of profits in new shares to a universal defined-benefit pension system under workers' control.
- Resolve the Arab/Israeli Conflict: Stop US aid to Israel and redirect it to reconstruction in Lebanon and the Palestinian territories until Israel ends its military attacks and occupations on Arab lands. Support international guarantees and enforcement of equal human rights and security for all Arabs and Israelis in a negotiated settlement that allows Palestinians the right of return and restitution and equitably shares scarce water and land.

Health Care for All

Howie Hawkins supports Medicare for All. Hillary Clinton does not.

In 1993, Hillary Clinton derailed a movement for national health insurance that had 70% public support. Instead, she pushed compulsory private health insurance, a position she still holds today with her support for the Massachusetts plan of government mandates and subsidies for private health insurance.

Clinton's legacy is the most inefficient and irrational system of health care financing in the world. Private health insurance spends 25-30% of premiums on overhead for paperwork, profits, and excessive executive salaries. It leaves 47 million Americans uninsured. The US spends twice as much per person as any other country on health care, yet ranks 37th in health care, according to the World Health Organization.

Medicare overhead is 3-5%. The efficiency of Medicare for All will enable us to cover every US resident and still save \$286 billion, according to Physicians for a National Health Program.
