Howie Hawkins has been an organizer in movements for peace, justice, labor, the environment, and independent politics since the late 1960s.

Howie is a candidate who puts his convictions on the line. He was convicted of criminal trespass for a civil disobedience action at the Syracuse office of the country's largest private health insurance company, WellPoint, in a November 2009 demonstration by single payer activists.

A former Marine, Howie helped organize opposition to the Vietnam War, led divestment campaigns against apartheid South Africa, and co-founded the anti-nuclear Clamshell Alliance in 1976 and the Green Party in the US in 1984. After attending Dartmouth College in the early 1970s, Howie worked in construction and organized cooperatives.

For the last decade, Howie has unloaded trailers at UPS, where he is a member of Teamsters Local 317. He is active in Teamsters for a Democratic Union, US Labor Against the War, and the Labor Campaign for Single Payer Healthcare.
